## Activities:

--Hand Print Fish: Trace your child's hand on a sheet paper and cut out 3-4 prints. Let your child color or paint each hand print. Turn the hand print sideways to look like a fish; add eyes. Your child can glue the hand prints on a sheet of blue paper to go along with Dr. Seuss' *One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish*.

--Hop and Pop! Lay bubble wrap on the floor and let your child jump on it for Dr. Seuss' story *Hop on Pop*.

--Balance Toys: The Cat in the Hat can balance many things. How many toys can you balance?

--Sound Hunt: Mr. Brown Can Moo and he can make other sounds too. Let's go on a sound hunt! Ask your child what sounds can be heard outside. Take a walk through your neighborhood, stopping periodically to listen for sounds. What do you hear? What makes that sound? How many sounds did you hear? (inspirationlaboratories.com)

← Yertle Egg Carton Turtles: Separate egg carton into 12 pieces for your child to decorate. Use paint/pompoms/pipe cleaners/etc. to make each piece look like a turtle. How many turtles can your child stack? (inspirationlaboratories.com)
