## Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear

## Activities:



-Toilet Paper Roll Bear: supplies needed are an empty toilet paper roll, brown paper, tan paper, yarn, marker, scissors, tape and glue. Cut out a head shape and 2 long rectangles with rounded ends (these will be the paws). Cut out a small circle from the tan paper to be the muzzle. Glue on muzzle and draw on facial features. Glue the head onto one of the rectangles. Next, cut a slit onto both sides of the top of the roll and 2 smaller slits onto the bottom. Stick one end of the yarn inside the tube through a top slit and tape to the inside of the tube. Wrap yarn around the tube, sticking the remaining end through one of the bottom slits and tape inside. Stick one of the rectangles through the bottom slits, making the lower paws. Stick the head and upper paws through the top slits, completing your bear. (idea from ourkidthings.com)

- Teddy Bear Picnic: eat lunch outside today and bring your teddy bear!

-Fork Paint Craft: supplies needed are white paper, washable brown paint, plastic fork, googly eyes, black and brown paper, scissors, and glue. Dip fork prongs in brown paint and stamp the fork all over the paper making the bear's fur. Cut out 2 ears and a nose. Once the paint is dry, glue on ears, nose, and googly eyes to make your bear.
