**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HEMET, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF
A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2021 FOR THE ELECTION OF
THE OFFICE OF CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 AS
REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE
STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW
CITIES**

11 The City Council of the City of Hemet (hereafter referred to as the “City Council”)
12 does resolve as follows:

13 **WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in
14 the State of California, a Special Municipal Election shall be held on Tuesday,
15 November 2, 2021 for the election of a Municipal Officer.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEMET DOES**
17 **HEREBY FIND AND RESOLVE TO:**

18 **SECTION 1.** That pursuant to the requirement of the laws of the State of
19 California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the
20 City of Hemet, California on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 a Special Municipal Election
21 for the purpose of electing one member of the City Council for the unexpired balance
22 of the term of office, approximately over three (3) years,

23 **SECTION 2.** That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and
24 content as required by law.

25 **SECTION 3.** That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to
26 coordinate with the Riverside County Registrar of Voters to procure and furnish any
27 and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and

1 paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the
2 election.

3 **SECTION 4.** That the polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock
4 (7:00) a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from the
5 time until eight o'clock (8:00) p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed,
6 pursuant to Elections Code §10242, except as provided in § 14401 of the Elections
7 Code of the State of California.

8 **SECTION 5.** That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election
9 shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

10 **SECTION 6.** That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given
11 and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional
12 notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

13 **SECTION 7.** That in the event of a tie vote (if any two or more persons receive
14 an equal and the highest number of votes for an office) as certified by the Riverside
15 County Registrar of Voters, the City Council, in accordance with Elections Code §
16 15651(b), shall conduct a special runoff election to resolve the tie vote and such
17 special runoff election is to be held on a Tuesday not less than 40 days nor more
18 than 125 days after the administrative or judicial certification of the election which
19 resulted in a tie vote.

20 **SECITON 8.** That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of
21 this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
